ALUMNI LEGACY AWARD NOMINATION ALUMNI RELATIONS

INTENTION

- The Alumni Legacy Award was first given in 2004 in conjunction with the College's 40th Anniversary and was established as a posthumous recognition to recognize an individual alumnus' contribution to the community.

ELIGIBILITY

- Candidate must fit the criteria of a "General Member" according to the Red Deer Alumni Association Bylaws.
(Article 3.1 General Membership shall be available to persons previously registered as students at Red Deer College who paid the prescribed College registration fee and attended three (3) for credit courses in any regular session(s), to include Trades and Industrial Training.)
- Candidates will remain nominated for a total of three years.

THE AWARD

- One or more awards are presented annually at Convocation.
- The recipient(s) family will receive a Certificate of Recognition.

NOMINATORS

- Red Deer College employees, students, alumni, and community members can nominate a Red Deer College Alumnus for the Alumni Legacy Award.

NOMINATION PACKAGE AND PROCESS

- Each confidential nomination package should include:
 - Nomination Form
 - Nomination Summary
 - Candidate's Consent Form
 - at least two additional confidential letters of support
- Nomination packages must be submitted to Alumni Relations at Red Deer College no later than April 12th.
- Further distribution of any or all parts of the nomination package, without the express written consent of Alumni Relations is strictly prohibited.

SCREENING AND SELECTION PROCEDURES

- 1) Composition of the Committee will consist of a minimum of three members of the Red Deer College Alumni Association Executive, one of which will be the Chairperson, as well as the Associate Vice President, Community Relations.
- 2) The award(s) will be presented at Convocation each year.
