Tim Gitzel Biography

Tim graduated in 1985 from Red Deer College as a University Transfer student in the Bachelor of Arts program. Among his many accomplishments while at the College, Tim made his mark as a centre on the Kings Hockey Team. His team won a silver medal at the Canadian Colleges Athletic Association (CCAA) Championship.

He went on to complete his education at the University of Laval in Quebec, and the University of Saskatchewan in Saskatoon. Gitzel holds a Bachelor of Arts degree and a Law degree.

Since graduating, Gitzel has enjoyed a diverse career in the fields of business, law, and government. For the past 13 years, he has attained several key leadership positions within the uranium mining industry in Canada and around the world.

Tim was in a senior executive position with AREVA, a large French nuclear company, in Paris, France. Most recently, Gitzel has been appointed Senior Vice President and Chief Operating Officer for Cameco Uranium Operations. He is responsible for all uranium mining and milling facilities in Saskatchewan, the United States and Kazakhstan, as well as uranium processing and fuel manufacturing operations in Ontario.

Born and raised in Saskatchewan, Tim and his wife Bonnie have two children. They currently live in Saskatoon.
