RDC Athletics is pleased to announce....

Aaron Schulha, RDC Kings Volleyball Head Coach, has been named as one of the assistant coaches for the FISU Games team this summer.

The purpose of the National B/FISU Team is to identify, select and train a group of athletes who have potential or demonstrated international skill and experience to represent Canada at the elite level. The goal for this year's B/FISU Team is for a top 10 finish at the 2009 World Universiade (FISU) Games in Belgrade Serbia, July 1-12.

The Universiade Games are open to competitors between the ages of 17 and 28 in the year of the games, who are full-time post secondary students (University, college, CEGEP) or have graduated from a post-secondary institution within the previous year of the event.

The top athletes, as identified by the national selection committee, will be invited to Selection Camp, April 30-May 3 at the Team Canada Men's Volleyball Centre in Gatineau. The camp will involve athlete selection for both the Senior A Team as well as the B/FISU Team. Approximately 28 athletes in total will be selected to train with either the Senior Team and/or the B/FISU National Team this year.
