Ivancic, a Basketball Alberta Centre of Performance athlete, has scored 30 plus points in three of her 4A high school games this year. She has received many player of the game awards including an all star award at the Totem Hoops tournament for the second year in a row. She also holds the title of being the best 3pt shooter in Spruce Grove's history of Sr Girls basketball. "Megan is a quick guard that has a great ability to score and attack. She will be a key component to improving our offensive threat. "



Lisa Ivanics, a 5'9 guard from Foremost High School in Southern Alberta is averaging 42 points and 17 rebounds a game.
