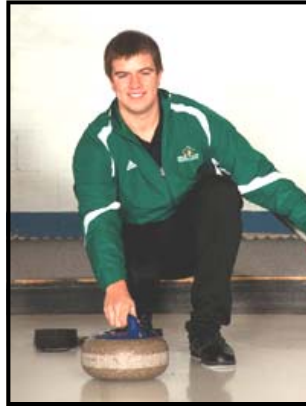


# ACAC Athletes of the Week
