Stefan Labrecque returns to Red Deer College after a four year leave to take over from mentor Craig Behan as Kings Basketball Interim Head Coach. Stefan has been involved in the basketball community in Alberta and Western Canada for over 15 years as a coach. He began his coaching career as an assistant with many of the community's well established coaches working within the youth ranks, and high school leagues. Stefan spent a great deal of time developing and working in Club Basketball, giving a framework and direction to a variety of players, a number of whom became College and University bound. Stefan spent four years as an assistant coach at RDC. During this time the Kings attended 3 Final Fours, just missing out on a trip to Nationals in 2003-04. After the 2006 season Stefan returned to Notre Dame High School to take over as Head Coach, where Coach Labrecque worked diligently to create with his staff one of the most respected High School basketball programs in Alberta. As a coach Stefan believes in developing a team that has a foundation built on 'family atmosphere'. Developing young men that are successful, independent and ready for the challenges of tomorrow is one of the most rewarding opportunities that exist. Stefan currently teaches at Notre Dame High School and resides in Red Deer with his wife Leeanne and their three daughters Ayla, Aubrey and Ainslee.
