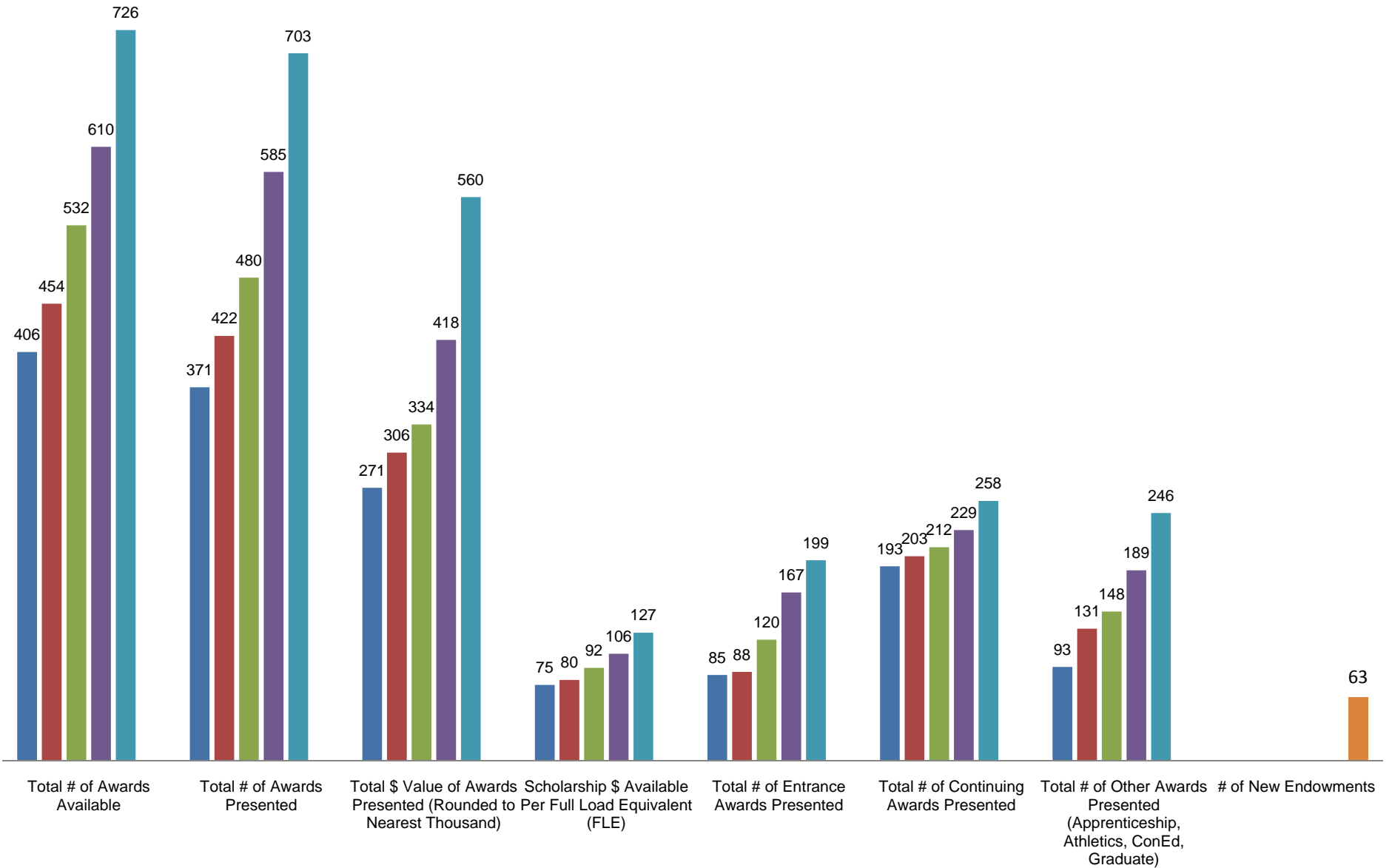

Comparative Results 2005-2009**

2009 compared to 2008 Calendar Year

1. Number of awards available grew 19% from 610 to 726.
2. Number of awards presented grew by 20% from 585 to 703.
3. Total dollar value of the awards presented grew by 34% from \$418,309 to \$560,148.
4. Scholarship dollars available per full load equivalent (fle) student numbers increased by 20% from fiscal year* from 2009 to 2008 with available dollars increasing from \$106/fle to \$127/fle.
5. Entrance awards grew by 28% from 155 to 199.
6. Continuing awards grew by 5% from 246 to 258.
7. Athletic, Apprenticeship, Graduate and Continuing Education awards grew by 30% from 189 to 246.

2008 compared to 2007 Calendar Year

1. Number of awards available grew by 15% from 532 to 610.
2. Number of awards presented grew by 22% from 480 to 585.
3. Total dollar value of the awards presented grew by 25% from 334,051.08 to \$418,308.65.
4. Scholarship dollars available per full load equivalent (fle) student numbers increased by 15% from fiscal year* from 2007 to 2008 with available dollars increasing from \$92/fle to \$106/fle.
5. Entrance awards grew by 39% from 120 to 167.
6. Continuing awards grew by 8% from 212 to 229.
7. Athletic, Apprenticeship, Graduate and Continuing Education awards grew by 28% from 148 to 189.

2007 compared to 2006 Calendar Year

1. Number of awards available grew by 17% from 454 to 532.
2. Number of awards presented grew by 14% from 422 to 480.
3. Total dollar value of the awards presented grew by 9% from \$306,391 to \$334,051.
4. Scholarship dollars available per full load equivalent (fle) student numbers increased by 15% from fiscal year* from 2006 to 2007 with available dollars increasing from \$80/fle to \$92/fle.
5. Entrance awards grew by 36% from 88 to 120.
6. Continuing awards grew by 4% from 203 to 212.
7. Athletic, Apprenticeship, Graduate and Continuing Education awards grew by 13% from 131 to 148.
