- Candidates are permitted to attempt a PLAR Challenge only once for each of the Bridging courses that are PLAR-eligible. I understand that ACP will be monitoring the results of PLAR Challenge exams received from the various colleges to identify any instances of repeated attempts to secure credit for the same course. I also understand that candidates who fail to comply with this requirement may jeopardize their ability to continue with the Registration process.
- PLAR is not be used to challenge a course which a candidate has previously failed, unless he/she is able to demonstrate subsequent completion of remedial learning through self-study and/or work experience applicable to the course to be challenged.
- The confidentiality of the examination process must be maintained. I agree not to provide any other candidates with advance knowledge of the content and focus of this examination.
