

#### Level 1 (equivalent to CLB Level 4)

Students in this introductory level will develop their basic English skills through various activities, including written exercises, role plays, videos, discussions, presentations, games and field trips. Regular homework assignments will reinforce concepts studied in class.

#### Level 2 (equivalent to CLB Level 5)

Students in this level will expand their basic English skills and begin using more complex grammar structures to increase their spoken and written fluency. This course will focus on authentic communication through individual, partner and group activities.

#### Level 3 (equivalent to CLB Level 6)

In this intermediate course, students will gain the skills needed to communicate confidently in authentic community settings. As well, they will be introduced to the fundamentals of academic speaking and writing.

#### Level 4 (equivalent to CLB Level 7)

Students in this high intermediate level will expand their academic skills in reading, writing, listening and speaking through essay writing, research, note-taking and longer presentations using a variety of rhetorical methods.

#### Level 5 (equivalent to CLB Level 8/9)

In this advanced course, students will continue developing their academic skills through modules such as library research, literary genres, and presentations in various authentic community settings. Students who successfully complete this course are qualified for entry into selected college programs.
