Where is it?

Red Deer College Arts Centre, Red Deer, Alberta

Red Deer is located in the heart of Central Alberta midway between Edmonton and Calgary, just 90 minutes by car from either centre. MusiCamp Alberta students live on campus in the residence facilities consisting of apartment-style accommodations. Student accommodations are arranged by age and gender. Each suite contains 4 single bedrooms, a bath and a kitchen/living room. Each student will have his or her individual bedroom with a locking door. As well, the college cafeteria will provide full meal service to MusiCamp Alberta staff and students including those with dietary restrictions.

What Else?

Students have the opportunity to take part in daily organized, supervised recreational activities. Activities include volleyball, basketball, soccer, as well as skit night, campfire sing-a-longs and movie night.

July 22 – August 4, 2012

Recommended for band students who have completed Grade 10 or higher with at least three years experience on their instrument. Included are full band rehearsals, small ensembles, private lessons, a wide variety of musicianship classes and nightly faculty concerts.

Intermediate Band(s)

July 22 – 28, 2012

Recommended for students in Grades 8, 9 or 10 with at least two years experience on their instrument. Included are full band rehearsals, small ensembles, private lessons, musicianship classes and nightly faculty concerts.

Senior Musical Theatre

July 29 – August 11, 2012

Recommended for students 14 years and older who have the desire to further develop skills in musical theatre including vocal technique, masterclasses, small ensembles, advanced performance techniques and choreography.

Junior Musical Theatre

August 5-11, 2012

If you are 8 – 13 years old and interested in song and dance this program is for you! Learn valuable skills in vocal technique, small and large ensemble work, performance techniques and choreography all based on a popular musical.

Piano Workshop

August 5-11, 2012

Recommended for any student with a minimum of Grade 5 RCM (or equivalent) piano proficiency. This exciting workshop will explore many facets of piano performance including masterclasses, private lessons, effective practice techniques, ensemble playing, jazz performance, accompanying, musicianship and nightly faculty concerts.
