FALL 2020: Waitlisted Programs

RDC began accepting applications for Fall 2020 on October 1, 2019. To date, the following programs are full and waitlists have begun:

- [Occupational and Physical Therapist Assistant Diploma](#)

Please encourage students who are interested in these programs to **apply as soon as possible** to be placed on the waitlist. A reminder that applicants can indicate both a first and second choice program on their application for admission (should the first choice program be full, applicants meeting admission requirements will be placed on the waitlist and considered for admission for their second choice program). Students applying to the programs mentioned above are strongly encouraged to indicate the [Pre-Health Sciences Certificate](#) as their second choice program.

The application fee is \$110 for domestic students and \$200 for international students. Students are able to [apply online](#) or in person.

FALL 2020: Tuition Fee Deposit

Effective October 1, 2019 new and returning students will be charged a non-refundable tuition fee deposit upon admission. The deposit will be applied directly to the total tuition due. The tuition fee deposit rates are as follows:

- Domestic Student = \$400.00
- International Student = \$1400.00

The tuition fee deposit **does not** apply to:

- Continuing students who have not missed registration in a major academic term
- Transitional Vocational Program (TVP) students
- Collaborative program students (with the exception of those admitted to the third or fourth year of the MRU Bachelor of Business Administration program)
