Your Standard First Aid certification **must be submitted any time after your admission and before the start of your program.**

Standard First Aid certification **IS REQUIRED** for the following programs:

- Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BScN)
- Occupational Therapist and Physiotherapist Assistant (OPTA)

Standard First Aid certification is **NOT REQUIRED** for the following programs:

- Health Care Aide (HCA)
- Medical Laboratory Assistant (MLA)
- Pharmacy Technician (PHTD)
- Practical Nursing (PN)
- Unit Clerk (UC)

What if you already have a current Standard First Aid certificate or card?

A current Standard First Aid certificate that is good for 3 years, and is dated within 3 years of September 30, 2021, is acceptable to meet this requirement.

- This certification is required one time only, at the start of the program. *You do not need to recertify during the program.*

Where can you get training?

- Standard First Aid training is provided by a number of organizations. Red Deer College accepts all Standard First Aid certifications; there is no specific provider required. A Google search will help you identify organizations in your area.
